David L. Hirsch, 80, of Braceville, died Saturday, April 16, 2011 at Trumbull Memorial Hospital in Warren. He was born July 19, 1930 in Warren, the son of Joseph G. and H. Louise (Sauers) Hirsch, and had lived in Trumbull County all his life.

Mr. Hirsch owned and operated Hirsch's Sohio on North Park Avenue and on Parkman Road for over thirty years. He was also the owner of the Warren Beverage Center on Elm Road. He was a fifty year-plus member of the Warren Barbershoppers, and also sang with the Just Friends group. A member of First United Methodist Church in Warren, he enjoyed golfing and spending time with his grandchildren.
