



## Eileen L. Behrens

November 30, 1921 - March 24, 2007

Eileen L. Behrens, 85, of Warren, died Saturday, March 24, 2007 at Hospice House in Poland. She was born November 30, 1921 in Champion, the daughter of Ernest O. and Beatrice (Turner) Mills, and had lived in the Warren area her entire life.

Mrs. Behrens was a June, 1939 graduate of Warren G. Harding High School and a December, 1961 graduate of All-Star Beauty School. She retired in 1982 from Madelein's Beauty Shop, and had been self-employed since then as a cosmetologist. She was a member of Central Christian Church and had sung in the choir.
