Florence T. Spelman, 107, formerly of Warren, died Tuesday, September 8, 2009 at Crandall Medical Center in Sebring. She was born May 18, 1902 in Kinsman, the daughter of Fred Gordon and Nellie (Strickland) Webber, and had lived in Trumbull County most of her life.

Mrs. Spelman had worked as a telephone operator for the Windham Telephone Company as well as in private industry.
