Harry G. "Mitch" Mitchell, 75, of Leavittsburg, died Thursday, September 8, 2005 at Mahoning Valley Hospital in Warren. He was born March 2, 1930 in Girard, the son of the late John E. and Birtha Spangler Mitchell, and had lived in Trumbull County all his life.
