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James F. Carr, Jr., 73, of Warren, died Friday, April 6, 2012 at home. He was born July 7, 1938 in Bolindale, the son of James F. and Freda Velma (Neiman) Carr, Sr., and had lived in Trumbull County all his life.

A graduate of Fowler High School, Mr. Carr served with both the U.S. Marines and the U.S. Air Force. He worked for Ohio Lamp for ten years and retired from General Motors, Lordstown, where he had been a union official in the 1970s and trained people in the safety and material departments.
