Martha S. "Marty" Johnson formerly of Perkinswood Blvd. NE, Warren, age 90 passed away Saturday February 4, 2006, after a brief illness at the Masonic Village in Swickley, Pa. She was born August 5, 1915 in Sharon PA, the daughter of the late Leroy E. and Jessie (Hamer) Shaner.
