Mary Elizabeth "Libby" Libby, 94, of Warren, died Sunday, December 9, 2007 at St. Joseph Health Center. She was born October 5, 1913 in Gratztown, Pa., the daughter of Robert and Elizabeth (Gardner) Pringle.

Mrs. Libby had worked in the family business, the Libby Construction Company of Warren and was a Warren charter member of the American Business Women's Association. She was an active member of First United Church of Christ, where she had served as church historian; as junior church director for 33 years; as a Sunday School teacher for 12 years; as president of the Heidelberg Guild; as an elder; and was the first woman elected as president of the consistory. She had also served as a volunteer and tutor at Roosevelt School. She enjoyed piano, organ, and crafts.
