Mary H. Thomas, 102, of Cortland and formerly of Warren, died Wednesday, January 19, 2011 at Lake Vista Retirement Community. She was born December 27, 1908 in Warren, the daughter of Harvey and Mantia (Charters) Hardman, and had lived in the Warren area all her life.
