Peter Testa, 86, of Warren, died Sunday, January 3, 2010 at St. Joseph Health Center. He was born January 30, 1923 in McIntyre, Pa., the son of Louis and Rose (Petrone) Testa.

Peter retired from Peerless Electric Motor Company in 1978. He served in the United States Army during World War II in the 735th Armored Tank Battalion in Belgium.
