Robert A. Bradley, 66, of Warren, died Friday, August 29, 2008 at his daughter's home in Warren. He was born November 13, 1941 in Warren, the son of Lee A. and Rina (Caporossi) Bradley, and had lived in the Warren area all his life.

Mr. Bradley was a 1959 graduate of Warren G. Harding High School and attended the Art Institute of Pittsburgh. A former Army reservist, he had worked as a draftsman for Wean Engineering, Alcan Aluminum, Republic Steel, and Electric Furnace in Salem.
