Robert M. Robison, 76, of Bristolville, died Saturday, January 19, 2008 at Forum Health - Trumbull Memorial Hospital. He was born October 3, 1931 in Port Matilda, Pa. the son of Ira and Amber (Cowher) Robison.

Mr. Robison served in the U.S. Army and worked for 34 years as a train operator for Republic Steel and LTV, retiring in 1990.
