Roy Eugene "Gene" Chalker, 78, of Warren, died Wednesday, August 13, 2008 at Forum Health - Trumbull Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. He was born May 10, 1930 in Warren, the son of Roy F. and Margaret (Turner) Chalker, and had lived in Trumbull County all his life.

Mr. Chalker was a graduate of Lordstown High School and retired, after 35 years as a metallurgical assistant, from Thomas Steel Strip, where he had been active with the NEMS Club. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Warren and was active in the adult Sunday School classes and the church's Navigators.
