Violet P. Lewis, 98, of Warren, died Friday, May 16, 2008 at Gillette Nursing Home. She was born November 12, 1909 in Southington, the daughter of John C. and Della E. (Hawkins) Preston, and had lived in Trumbull County her entire life.

Mrs. Lewis attended the Southington Schools and began her working career as a clerk for Muter's Gift & Card Shop in downtown Warren. In her forties, she attended the Warren Beauty School and became a beautician. She also worked thirty-one years at Packard Electric, retiring in 1971.

She was active with Rebekah Lodge; Morning Light Chapter No. 80, Order of the Eastern Star (50-year member); Warren Assembly No. 77, Social Order of Beauceant (50-year member); White Fez; and had been MCO of Ali Baba Cauldron.
