William "Frank" Isner, 72, of Weathersfield, died Sunday, November 1, 2009 at Mahoning Valley Hospital in Warren. He was born March 6, 1937 in Elkins, W. Va., the son of Wilbert and Zeta (Flanagan) Isner, and was raised in Baltimore, Md. before moving to Ohio.
